Background: Several years ago LDA of Michigan joined as a LDA Healthy Children Project (HCP) state partner. The HCP project is dedicated to helping families learn about existing and emerging science linking certain chemical exposures to learning, behavioral, and developmental disabilities. LDA would now like to partner with other organizations to help inform families throughout Michigan about toxic substances in the environment, how they may impact children's health, and to find out how they may join with others to make a difference in protecting the health of our children.

Specifically, LDA would like to co-sponsor up to three statewide conferences of 501(c)3 non-profit organizations which are dedicated to children's health issues and family memberships. Those selected will receive \$500 from the LDA HCP to help support your overall conference.

Grantee will be required to:

1. Host a 30 minute keynote address on children's environmental health at your annual statewide conference (HCP will identify a speaker for this keynote address)
2. Print at least one article on children's environmental health and the Healthy Children Project in your newsletter or e-publication (HCP can provide articles);
3. Acknowledge the Learning Disabilities Association of Michigan's Healthy Children Project in all of your conference/event promotional materials (flyer, brochures, etc.);
4. Promote the LDA of Michigan's Healthy Children Project free e-Newsletter to your members
5. Provide HCP with a free exhibit table and
6. Following conference, submit a written summary including the number of attendees, copies of conference materials, and evaluations for the HCP-sponsored presentation.

Currently open for applications. Applicants are encouraged to submit applications as soon as possible.
